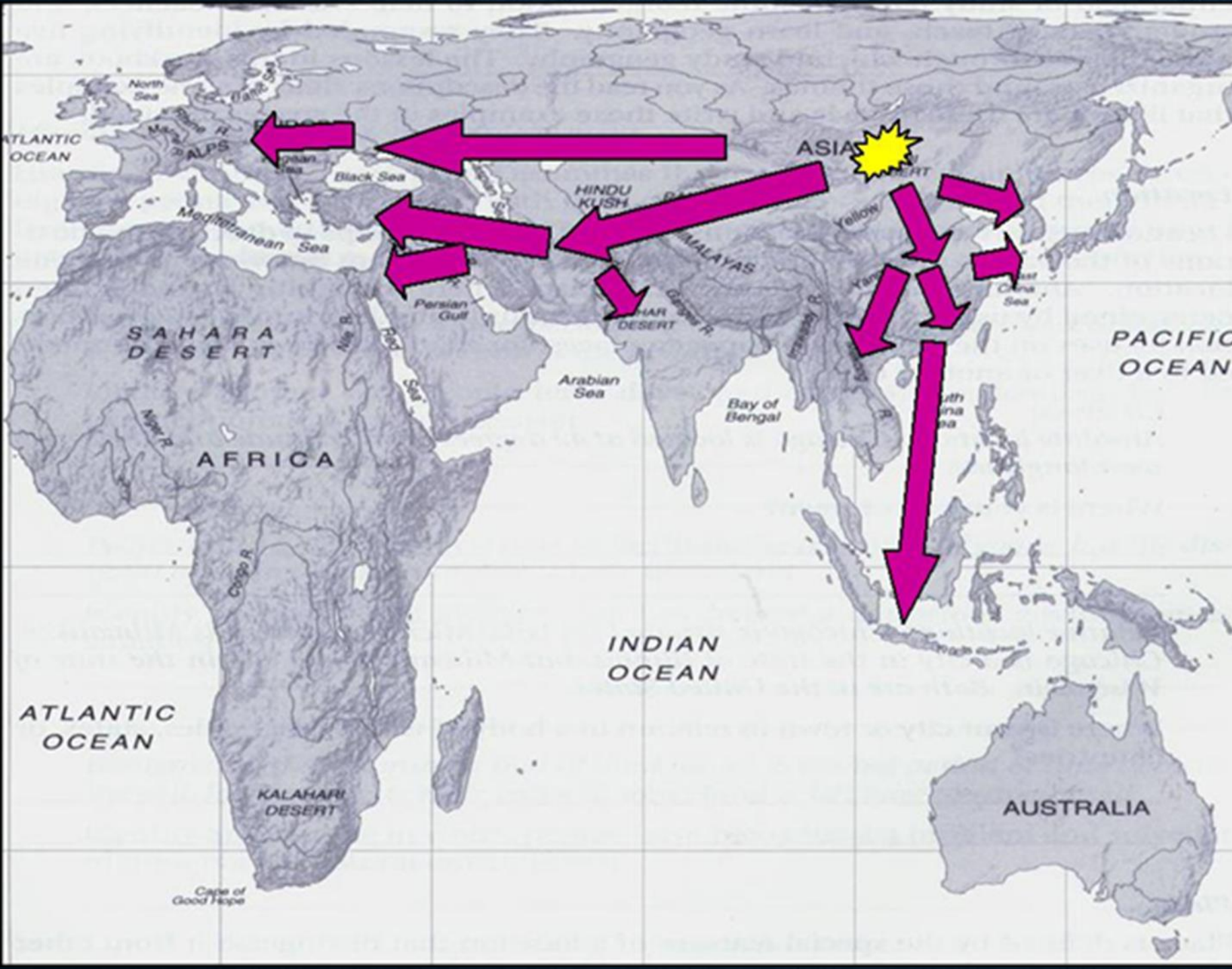

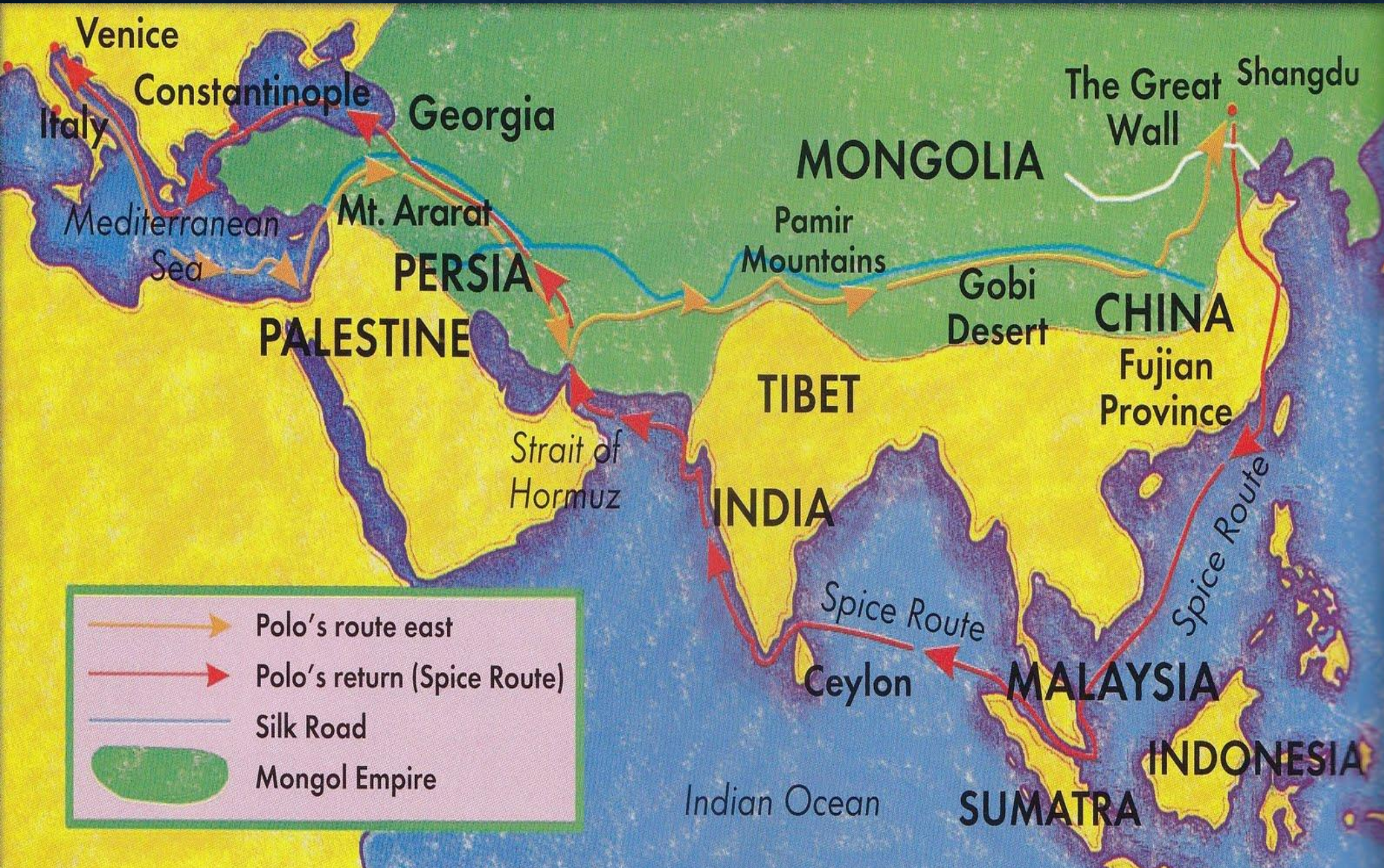


Mongol Conquests and Expeditions 1211-1300 CE

New Ideas from China to Europe



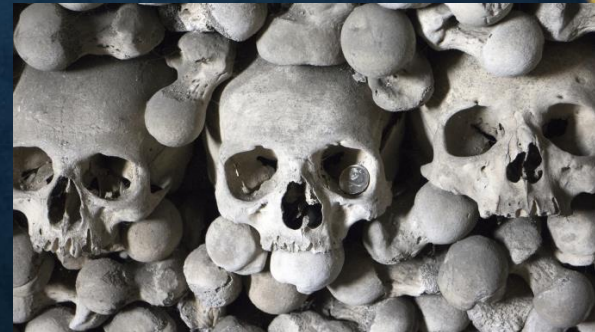
